## Service School Information

To: All Fulton Representatives and Dealers,

The Fulton Companies will be holding technical service seminars here at the plant in Pulaski, N.Y. on November 7th through 10th. These two-day schools will combine in-depth classroom instruction as well as hands on training. The seminars are designed for the field service technician as well as the end-user, but are beneficial for new salesmen as well. There is a limit of 10 persons per class. Openings will be filled on a first come first serve basis.

**Fulton Hydronic Heaters** will be covered November 7 and 8th. The first half of the day will be in the classroom. Topics of discussion will include construction, installation, operation, controls, maintenance and troubleshooting. The second half of the day will be hands-on training consisting of set-up and preventative maintenance. Continental breakfast will be at 8:00 with classes to start at 8:30. All training will last roughly 7 hours per day.

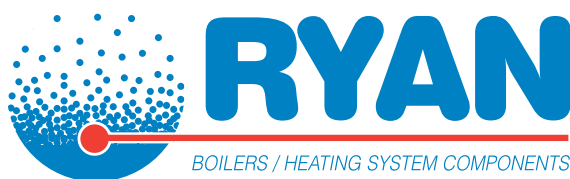
**Fulton Vantage Heaters** will be covered . The first half of the day will be in the classroom. Topics of discussion will include construction, installation, operation, controls, maintenance and troubleshooting. The second half of the day will be hands-on training consisting of set-up and preventative maintenance. Continental breakfast will be at 8:00 with classes to start at 8:30. All training will last roughly 7 hours per day.

**Vertical Tubeless Boilers** will be covered . The first day of classes will be in the classroom. Topics of discussion will include construction, installation, operation, controls, water management, maintenance and troubleshooting. The second day of classes will be entirely hands-on training consisting of set-up and preventative maintenance. Continental breakfast will be at 8:00 with classes to start at 8:30. All training will last roughly 7 hours per day.

**Thermal Fluid Heaters** will be covered November 9th and 10th. The first day of classes will be in the classroom. Topics of discussion will include construction, installation, operation, controls, system layout, maintenance and troubleshooting. The second day of classes will involve hands-on training consisting of set-up and preventative maintenance. Continental breakfast will be at 8:00 with classes to start at 8:30. All training will last roughly 7 hours per day.

All classes will be formatted in such a manner as to address all students training needs in as much depth as required. A continental breakfast and lunch will be provided for each day of class. One evening per class, an outing with dinner will also be provided.
